and plan to spend about 90 minutes

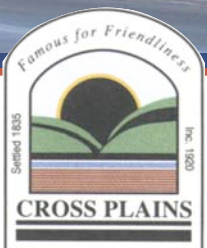
Location: American Legion Hall (2217 American Legion Drive)

The event starts and ends at the American Legion Hall and will occur rain or shine. In the event of rain, all activities will take place inside the Hall. Accommodations also will be provided for those unable to take the short walk down to the Creek.
