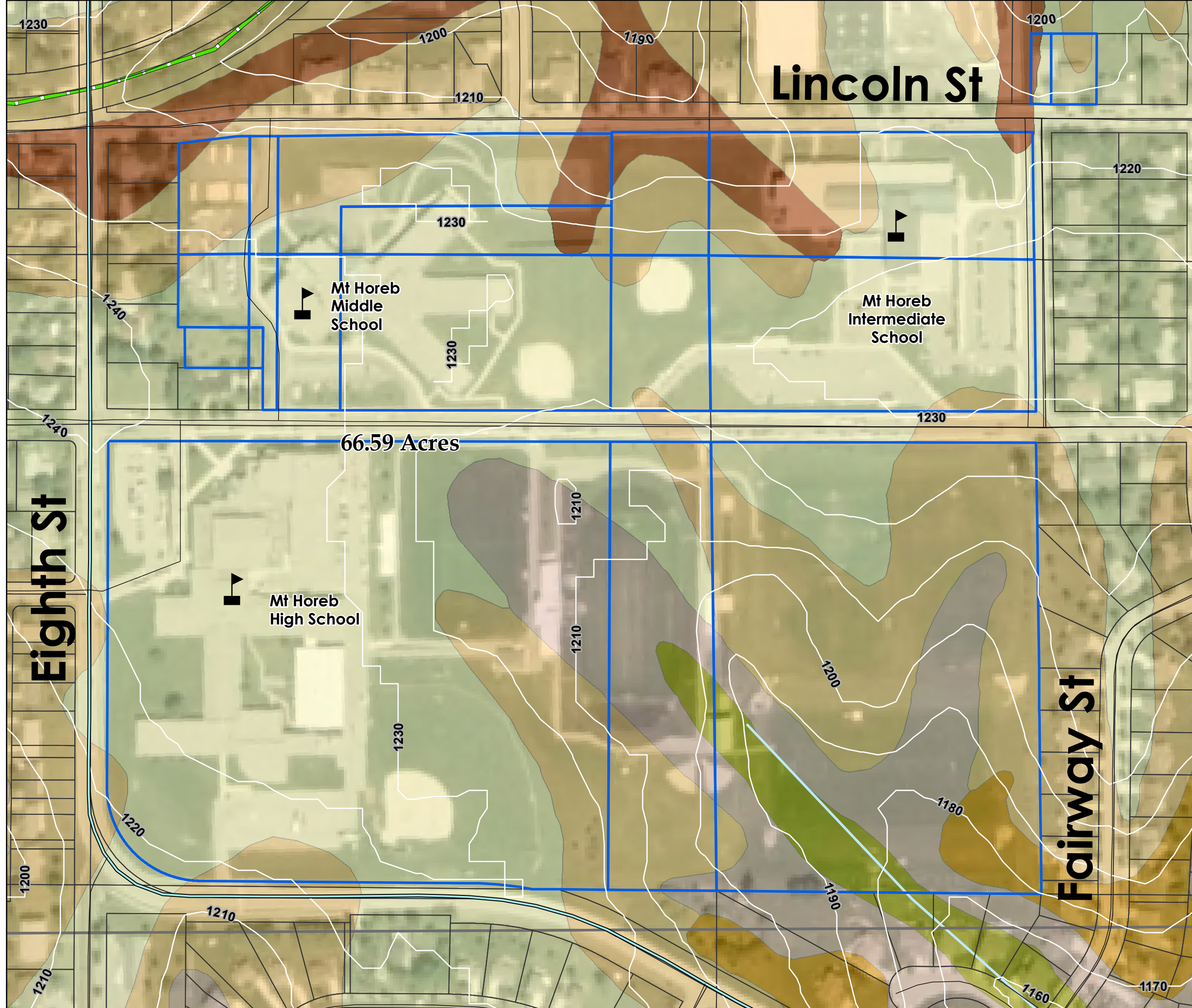

























Mount Horeb High School Siting Map

-  EdB2 - Edmund silt loam - 2-6%
-  TrB - Troxel silt loam - 1-3% Slope
